Hinds Co-Operating Parish

A Special Service will be held on Sunday 16th May at 2pm, at St. Lukes Hinds, to celebrate its Pipe Organ, which was commission in September 1920 as a memorial to the local soldiers that did not return home from WW1. Mr Graham Gunn of Ashburton will be the Organist, and Mrs Jo Wilson, a local Historian will speak.

Have a Go Project update: Seddon's Community Garden

The people of Awatere-Flaxbourne parish applied for a grant from the Have-a-Go fund to assist with their Community Garden in Seddon. The monies received were put towards the purchase of seedlings (at a reduced cost from a friendly nursery in Blenheim), extending their irrigation system, and, most recently, adding a tunnel house to raise seedlings in.

The main garden block was planted in seedlings for winter use, and they are just coming on stream now and looking very healthy. People are learning to take just what they will use today, and also to preserve the growth of the brassica leaves etc.

A generous owner of horses gives a manure/sawdust mix which is ideal for the soil texture as well as its nutrition. Looking ahead, they will rest some beds in readiness for spring planting and are wanting to break in some new areas which had been under the demolished church for 70 years.
