Speaker: Malcolm Gordon

Theme: Speech for the Speechless: Exploring Lament as God's Gift in the Midst of Suffering.

Rev Malcolm Gordon will invite us into a series of reflections on the Biblical practice of lament, rooted in both the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures. Lament is a practice that provides an alternative to fatalism—that whatever *is* happening must be *meant* to happen—and engages our relationship with God in circumstances which would otherwise deny or stifle it. It is a practice that can enrich our own spiritual lives, as well as deepening our pastoral capacity to "walk through the valley of the shadow of death."

Malcolm will draw upon his song-writing and creative worship leading as part of the retreat. He is currently in the final year of his doctoral study on the spirituality of suffering in Early Christianity, and continues to teach in worship and Presbyterianism at KCML.

Rev Donald Malloch

We have been advised of the death of Rev Donald Malloch, peacefully on March 26, at Charles Upham Retirement Village, Rangiora, aged 90 years. Don had his 90th birthday on 24 March - 2 days before his death. A celebration of Don's life was held on 31 March.

Don attended the Theological Hall from 1971-73. He was ordained at Iona, in the suburb of Aranui, Christchurch Presbytery on 27 February 1975. Don's ministry saw him work with and shared in the devotional life of the Community of the Sisters of Mercy that was working in Aranui at the time. He also worked with George Ehau, a Maori Pentecostal pastor working in Aranui, and together they opened a Drop-In House that provided refuge and a home for homeless young men in the community. Don and George were heavily involved in the Wai Ora Trust which had a market garden in Harewood that provided work and training for mentally and physically disabled

people and produced food for the community.

Don later married Ann O'Regan who was a nun in the Aranui Community. Together Don and Ann (who trained and worked as a lawyer after she left the Order) carried on that work. Don was widely respected by those he worked alongside and amongst.

Following his ministry at Iona, Don worked in chaplaincy at Princess Margaret, Burwood and Hillmorton Hospitals. He was granted the status of Minister Emeritus on 31 March 1991.

We give thanks for Don's life and ministry and pray for Ann and the extended family.
