## Notes from the October meeting of Presbytery Council

[the meeting was held on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> October]

**Present**: Rev Dr Andrew Nicol (Moderator), Christine Arnold, Maureen Bishop, Rev Rory Grant, Rev Jason King, Ann McMillan, Rev Jon Parkes, Rev Brent Richardson, and Rev Martin Stewart (Executive Officer). There was an apology from Lyn Heine who was on new grandparent duties!

**Devotions:** Andrew reflected on Jesus' teaching on the Great Commandment, and how the love of God and neighbour are not to be disconnected. The pandemic and public health advice is bringing fracture into the life of families, church congregations, and the community. How do we extend Christian care to those we disagree with? The Good Samaritan parable, associated with Luke's version of the Great Commandment question, reveals that the neighbour is not who you thought it would be. Seeing how much God loves us leads us to loving our neighbour and that is to have specific application.

The Minutes of the Presbytery Council meeting held on Thursday 23rd September 2021 were ratified, as was the approval for Crossway Community Church to look at purchasing a property.

#### Moderator

Andrew noted activity including pastoral support of some individuals, meeting with the heads of denominations (including a meeting with the DHB and an MP), a Zoom conversation on the proposed Covid Traffic Light framework; and an 'exit-interview' he and Rev Phyll Harris conducted with Rev Barry Ayers. A discussion was had about the role of the Moderator and ways to strengthen the key relationship between the Moderator and the Executive Officer.

#### **Executive Officer**

- After a very positive Performance Review it was agreed to enter a one-year contract with Abi Trevathan to continue serving as the Resource Team Leader with the intention that it will be extended for a further two years subject to ongoing funding being attained. A salary increase was also agreed to.
- Discussion on the Covid-19 framework changes and implications. A process will initially be led by Council of Assembly.
