Step 10) November: Measure & Celebrate

Bible verse: Luke 15:8-10 "And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbours together and says, 'Rejoice

with me; I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

'Big Idea': The angels of God celebrate over each person who turns their life away from sin and towards God. Salvation includes right relationships with God, others and the world. Tackling the challenge of the waste we produce makes us part of the solution instead of part of the problem. So celebrate what you have achieved and give glory to God.

Questions - for reflection & discussion

What place does sustainable living have in God's salvation and Christian discipleship? As you have explored the problem of landfill waste and worked towards solutions, what have you learned?

How has this informed your faith?

Action Steps for November

Measure your total waste again. Look back to what you did in Step 2 (March). Use the same time frame and system again to measure the rubbish across all bins. Report to your family or church. What have you achieved?
