Volunteers are required by the Powhiri Refugee Family Support Settlement Service to provide assistance to former refugees in Christchurch.

Help is needed with such things as:

- welcoming new arrivals at the airport
- help with grocery shopping
- teaching whanau to use public transport
- providing transport to school, GP appointments etc.
