## Presbyterian Women Aotearoa New Zealand Special General Meeting

Following declining membership of PWANZ in recent years a motion was put at the 2021 AGM that a Futures Review group be formed to consider ways forward for PWANZ as a group. From that group a recommendation was put at the PWANZ AGM on 24 September 2022 that PWANZ be closed down. The following recommendation was moved and accepted by those present at the AGM

## "Becoming Pākehā" an evening with John Bluck Transitional Cathedral, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 7.30pm

You are invited to come and hear John Bluck, retired Anglican Bishop, speak about growing up and living in this land, and about looking forward to the future we can all help create. He recently released a book called "Becoming Pākehā, A journey between two cultures" that many have found very helpful in shaping this ongoing bi-cultural/multicultural conversation. A koha will be taken on the night.

John's story has its share of pain, and at the same time, it is full of good humor and hope.

This is a Te Raranga presentation. Te Raranga is an Interchurch Network, supported by almost all churches in Christchurch.

#### Brother Peter Bray FSC in Christchurch

Brother Peter is the Kiwi Vice-Chancellor of Bethlehem University and will speak on **Thursday 2 February**, 7.30pm at the **Villa Maria College Auditorium**. Br Peter will

provide a brief historical perspective and the impact the situation is having on Israelis and Palestinians and particularly the students at Bethlehem University. He will consider what justice issues are involved and what needs to happen for peace to come. All are welcome.

**Recommendation:** That Presbyterian Women Aotearoa New Zealand (PWANZ) be closed down. In liaison with the National Executive all Parishes to be notified that their support for our continuing mission in Aotearoa are welcome but the current model of the organisation is unsustainable. The Special Consultative Status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council will lapse.

To progress this recommendation, which has brought up a significant number of issues (outlined below), a **Special General Meeting** is required, and this will be held **on 25 February 2023 at St John's in the City, Wellington.** 

#### Issues include:

- Ageing membership & declining finances (currently only 111 financial members)
- Vacancies on Executive (including President)
- How to maintain a woman's voice with the Presbyterian Church, especially at a local level
- Lapsing of Special Consultative Status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council
- Loss of a dedicated missional outlook
