

St Paul's KidzKlub Family Outreach: `Whānau Night Events'

St Paul's Presbyterian Church in Kaikōura offers a free community after-school group for 5-11 year old children. This is regularly attended by 15-20 children, many of whom do not attend church regularly or at all. KidzKlub is attempting to connect with families in the community, by organising fun events that invite families to find out more about what's been happening at KidzKlub, build whanaungatanga (meaningful connections and relationships). The events include a short message based on Biblical stories or principles, and we always share a meal.

On Sunday 25th June, we organised a MasterChef event, with a Pressure Test, Blind Taste Test and Mystery Box Challenge. We are still figuring out the best format for these family connections, in terms of frequency and content. This event seemed to be greatly enjoyed by the participants, and re-connected us with a whānau we had not heard from in quite a while.

KidzKlub has also been blessed by an opportunity to meet the residents of our local healthcare/ assisted living rest home. We did a craft together and sang a song for the residents. This is the feedback from their end:

"We had a lovely time with all the children Nathaniel and team. They were beautifully behaved and super respectful. The final results of having their handprints taken was a lovely surprise for the kaumātua. They also loved your waiata and we are all looking forward to your next visit Kidzclub."
