Rev Max Garrity

We have been advised of the death of Rev Max Garrity on 19 August, at Hutt Hospital, aged 96 years.

Max attended the Theological Hall between 1965 to 1967, and was ordained and inducted at Mangakino, Waikato Presbytery, in December 1967.

Max and Mabel were married in September 1970.

Max was then called to Christchurch North Parish in September 1973, and next to Waikaka Valley, Mataura Presbytery, in February 1986.

He retired and was granted the status Minister Emeritus by Christchurch Presbytery on 31 December 1989. Max and Mable moved north, and Max transferred his status as Minister Emeritus to Wellington Presbytery, 1 January 2014.

Mabel passed away in March 2018.

We give thanks for Max's life and ministry and pray for the family.
