Request from Gail for Supply for an Anglican Parish

Although I work for the Presbyterians, I am an Anglican, worshipping with the Mount Herbert Anglican Parish (settlements in the Lyttelton Harbour basin).

Two of our churches - St Cuthbert's Church in Governors Bay and St Andrew's Church in Diamond Harbour – have a Covenant whereby on the first Sunday of each month we have a service in either the Methodist or Presbyterian tradition, usually a Communion service. We have all the Methodist Sundays covered, but still need people for the Presbyterian services. Some things to note:

- The services are at 9.00am at Governors Bay and 10.30am at Diamond Harbour
- Dates for 2025 are

 - 2 November
- Remuneration rate is set by the Anglican Diocese so is \$250 for the two services, plus mileage.
