Following on from the "Investing for Mission" Conference in 2023, we will offer a 2-day conference event. Sam will be the keynote speaker and conversation partner and will also give a public lecture at the University of Otago on Thursday 21 August at 5.15pm.

Sam is a well-known author, speaker, theologian and missiologist. His framework of Community, Commerce, Culture and Congregational Initiatives is part of his work on an incarnational theology of church culture, innovation and presence in a secular society.
